(NOTICE INVITING EXPRESSION OF INTEREST)

Bureau of Civil Aviation Security(BCAS) invites Expression of Interest(EOI) from leading Information Technology(IT) Companies to partner in implementation of the project of web based centralized secure and uniform system for bio-metric access control through smart cards at all airports in India.

Background :

BCAS is an attached office of the Ministry of Civil Aviation. It is responsible for laying down the standards for pre-embarkation security and anti-sabotage measures in respect of civil flights ensuring their compliance through regular inspections and security audits. One of the important functions of BCAS is to regulate the access to all airports in the country. For this purpose, BCAS issues Airport Entry Passes(AEPs) to all individuals for access control through contactless smart cards at airports all over India with Biometric mechanism for monitoring/control of the movements of personnel into the airports. The doors and access points will be released only to authorized personnel after they have been identified by the system. Each entry/exit will be logged centrally for future reference. The system shall also be able to generate any level of information required on the person available in the building at any given point of time. The system shall provide comprehensive historical data of all personnel who have visited the building. The solution will have minimal manual operation for overall success.

Eligibility Criteria:

- a. The interested organization should be India based reputed institution with extensive experience in project development, management, financing, implementation and monitoring of access control projects.
- b. The organization should have implemented at least one project in India where access control has been provided for at least 10,000 persons.
- c. The firm should have at least five years experience in designing or consulting security systems.

Scope of Work :

- a. To formulate strategy, approach and methodology/mode of implementation of the access control system project.

- b. To assist BCAS in final preparation of Techno-feasibility report, detailed project report
- c. To prepare project implementation roadmap.
- d. To assist BCAS in selection of firm, contractors etc. for access control works.
- e. To assist BCAS in tendering processes for selection of machinery suppliers/ equipments etc.
- f. To continue to provide support for management of the system for one year after complete installation of access control system.
- g. To arrange various documents required to be executed.
- h. Any other issue(s) which may be required for successful execution of the project.

Selection Procedure:

The interested organization would be called for a presentation before a committee. The committee would examine the proposal of each firm alongwith their technical presentation and would recommend the short listed firm for appointment as consultant on nomination basis.
