NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the August, 2016

G.S.R. ___(E). --- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of Civil Aviation Security Organisation, Civil Aviation Department (Group A & B) Recruitment Rules, 1980, published vide Notification No.A.12018/2/1979-E.1 dated 18.09.1980, and subsequently amended in December, 1983, October, 1986 and April, 1993, the President hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Director General (DDG) in the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security, an attached office under the Ministry of Civil Aviation, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:-

(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Civil Aviation (Bureau of Civil Aviation Security) Deputy Director General Recruitment Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale:-

The number of posts, its classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto, shall be as specified in Column (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these Rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications, etc.:-

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification: - No person –

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having his spouse living,

Or

(b) who, have a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the Personal Law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

5. Power to relax:- Whether the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Savings: - Nothing in these Rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for persons belonging to Scheduled Caste or the Scheduled Tribe, Ex-Servicemen, other backward classes and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 3: For the purposes of appointment on deputation/promotion basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on 6th Central Pay commission has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendation of the Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised pay of scale into one grade with a common grade pay/pay scale, and where this benefit will extended only for the posts(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up-gradation.

By promotion:

Officers holding the post of Joint Director/Regional Director in BCAS in Pay Band-3 (Rs.15,600-39,100/-) with Grade Pay Rs.7600/- with five years regular service in the grade.
